‘There’s A Lotto Gold In Them There Hills!’
National Lottery players in Glasgow are urged to stake their claim

Jack Milroy, organiser of May’s highly successful Glasgow’s Festival of Americana, Big Big Country, headed into the ‘wild’ West End to join the search for Glasgow’s latest lottery millionaire – the missing jackpot winner who is yet to ride off into the sunset with their £1.6 million fortune.

He put up ‘Wanted’ posters today (24 May 2006), to capture the attention of the mystery Lotto ticket-holder, who matched all six numbers to win a £1.666,667 share of the £5 million Jackpot-Only Draw on Saturday 29 April 2006. Players who bought a ticket for the main Lotto draw on Saturday 29 April 2006 automatically had the same line(s) of numbers entered into the £5 million Jackpot-Only Draw.

The mystery Lotto ticket-holder in Glasgow now has until 5.30pm on 26 October 2006 to come forward with the winning ticket and make their claim. The winning numbers for the £5 million Jackpot-Only Draw on 29 April were 4, 10, 23, 36, 37 and 49.

If no-one comes forward with the winning ticket before the prize claim deadline, then the prize money, plus all the interest generated, will go to the Good Causes – adding to the £18.5 billion already raised through lottery ticket sales over the last 11 years.

A National Lottery spokesperson said: “We are desperate to find these ticket-holders and unite them with their winnings, as we now have a hat trick of unclaimed prizes in Glasgow. Whoever they are, wherever they are, there is still plenty of time to claim so please get out the old shopping receipts, look through pockets and dig down the back of the sofa. The champagne is on ice and all we need now are the names to put on those cheques.”

There are currently two other outstanding prizes that have still not been claimed in the Glasgow area. The first prize worth £110,935 is from the Lotto draw on Saturday 4 March 2006, and the missing ticket-holder has until 31 August 2006 to come forward with their winning ticket and claim this prize. The winning Lotto numbers on 4 March 2006 were 1, 16, 22, 32, 33, 40 and the bonus ball was 48.

The second prize worth £65,720 dates from the Lotto draw on Saturday 18 March 2006. The winning Lotto numbers for that draw were 7, 10, 22, 24, 34, 44 and the bonus ball was 18. The lucky ticket-holder has until 5.30pm on 14 September 2006 to come forward and make their claim.

To jog Lotto players' memories, on 29 April 2006, Gnarl's Barkley was dominating the charts with *Crazy* – while *Freedomland* starring Samuel L Jackson and Julianne Moore had just opened at the cinema. Closer to home, Glasgow Rangers beat Kilmarnock 3-1 in Scottish Premier League, while audiences at the Citizens Theatre were enjoying a performance of *An Enemy of the People*.

With all National Lottery draws, players have 180 days from the day of the draw to claim their win if they have the winning ticket. Anyone who believes they have the winning ticket for any of the National Lottery draws within the 180-day deadline should call the **National Lottery Line** on **0845 910 0000**.

Anyone concerned about lost or unchecked tickets may like to consider setting up a National Lottery Subscription, playing Lotto Online, via their mobile phone, or using the Sky Active service on digital TV. Numbers can be entered in advance and lucky winners automatically receive a cheque or are notified online if their numbers come up.
